Super Smiles for Your Child is a web-based educational experience. Families with young children, especially those with disabilities, will find lots of short videos that explain the oral health impact of specific disabilities such as autism, cerebral palsy, and a g-tube.

In addition, there are 4 different tracks to have fun exploring. Topics include Smart Snacking for Healthy Smiles, Beating Brushing Battles, Overcoming Oral Habits, and having Dynamic Dental Visits. Each track includes fun videos, songs and games that families can engage in together while learning about having a healthy mouth.

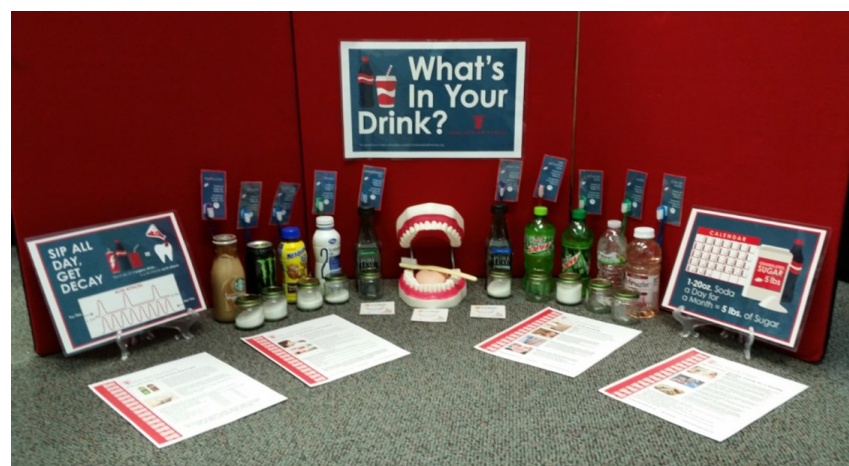
Sugary Drink Display

The Sugary Drink Display is a fun and educational way to discover the amount of sugar in popular drinks. Perfect for all ages, the drink display shows how many teaspoons of sugar are in popular drinks such as chocolate milk, sports drinks, soda, and more.

You can borrow it free for 30-days or purchase a display to have on hand.

Each display contains the following:

- 10 commonly purchased beverages
- 10 glass jars with corresponding sugar amounts
- Labels for each drink listing its sugar amount
- 4 oral health educational flyers on juice, soda, healthy eating, and toothbrushing
- 3 laminated posters

Magnets

Oral Health Kansas has two magnets available to show families how to be aware of what they drink. Each is a 5.5" x 4.25" magnet that is a great reminder on refrigerator doors.



Did you know?

Each time you take a sip of a sugary drink, your teeth experience a 20-minute acid attack.

Drinking sugary drinks only at mealtimes reduces exposure of teeth acid, which can cause tooth decay.

Sip All Day Get Decay Magnets

Did you know?

If you drink one 20-ounce soda each day for a month, you will have consumed the equivalent of a five pound bag of sugar!

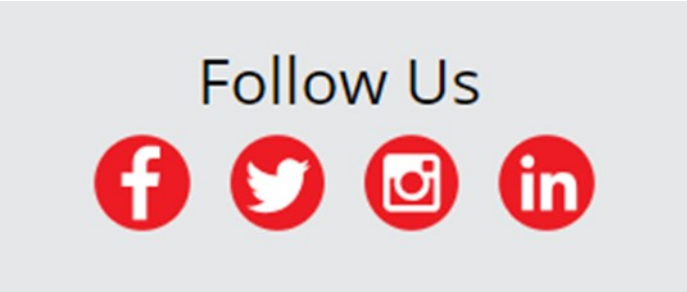
