

2024 Call for Poster Presentations

Oral Health Kansas invites proposals for posters for exhibition during the Conference on Oral Health at the Kansas State University Olathe Campus on Friday, November 8, 2024. To learn more about the conference, please visit the conference webpage.

Any poster presentation that is of interest to students, faculty, practitioners, and other partners in oral and public health is appropriate for Conference Planning Committee review. Applications are open to anyone in the dental, medical, or public health fields who would like to present information on their oral health, medical dental integration project, or other project or research.

Categories for poster presentations:

- Basic science and/or clinical research
- Clinical applications, techniques or tips
- Laboratory applications, techniques or tips
- Community oral health programs or grant projects
- Interprofessional collaboration
- Training and education

Requirements:

- A maximum of two presenters will be permitted for each poster presentation. All presentations are conducted at individual poster stations.
- Posters should be 3'x 4' (36" x 48"). The committee will provide a display board to attach the poster.
- No power outlets will be provided. Presenters must have fully charged batteries that will last the duration of the presentations if a personal computer is used, if needed.
- The sale of materials or products is not allowed at any poster presentation, and we discourage the use of commercial names in presentations. Advertising matter, commercial promotion, and solicitation of sales of any type are prohibited.
- Drugs must be identified by their generic or chemical formula, rather than by commercial trade name.

Posters must:

- Be well written, clear, and organized
- Be original, timely, and relevant to the Conference on Oral Health
- Develop ideas, offer significant conclusions, and provide useful and practical findings
- Provide a good visual description of the project
- Demonstrate innovative thinking

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION: Monday, September 30, 2024 Decisions will be announced on Monday, October 7, 2024

Proposal Submission:

Submit a title and summary of the project or research that is no more than 350 words, along with the primary presenter's name, address, phone number, and e-mail address. Proposals must be submitted using this <u>Google Form</u>. Presenters must clearly state who will serve as the contact person for future communications, as acknowledgement of acceptance, etc. will only be forwarded to one contact person.
