## CAVITY FREE AT THREE: F. A. Q.s

- Who should attend the training?

*We suggest including the following staff:*

- *Those who will be providing the fluoride varnish application and referral (physician, NP, PA, RN)*
- *Those who will be providing the oral health education and patient documentation*
- *Those who will be promoting the integration of oral health*
- *Those who will be billing KanCare for the fluoride varnish*
- *Those responsible for ordering supplies*
- *Those responsible for creating program policy*

- How long will the training take?

*We estimate the total training will be about 2 hours. The first hour will be all presentation and focus on the basics of oral health. The second part will include conversations on how to implement oral health into your overall health services and hands-on practice for applying fluoride varnish.*

- How much does the training cost?

*Thanks to the support of the KDHE Bureau of Oral Health, there is no cost to your organization for training. In addition, you will also receive a starter supply of toothbrushes, fluoride varnish, and educational materials. We will also be available for ongoing technical support. In return, we ask that each quarter you provide us with the number of children you provide oral health services to and share any oral health stories that demonstrate success of your integration efforts as well as any barriers that we can help address.*
