Don't Risk Losing Your Health Coverage!

Medicaid (KanCare) renewals have begun! Make sure to give the KanCare Clearinghouse your updated address, phone number or

any other contact information that has recently changed. There is even a little chat bot at the bottom of the Clearinghouse webpage that allows you to update your contact information quickly. Doing this will help the KanCare Clearinghouse contact you when your renewal is due and may help you avoid a gap in coverage.

The Danger of Oral Health Home Remedies

A <u>visual report</u> from CareQuest Institute finds that half of adults who experienced an oral health problem in the last 12 months used a home remedy for the problem â€" a decision that isn't always safe. Some of the dangerous home remedies included pain medication prescribed for another purpose, illegal narcotics, a needle to lance a gum abscess,

and alcohol. The report emphasizes the importance of having a regular dentist for ongoing prevention and treatment, so please don't turn to these potentially harmful solutions to treat tooth pain.
